Notes:

1. Pursuant to Article 16 of the Regulations for Course Registration at I-Shou University, students who conduct inter-division or inter-college course registration shall pay the difference, if any, pursuant to the applicable regulations and rules of the University.
2. The tuition and other required fees for students enrolled at the Division of Continuing Education are calculated based on the number of credits or the number of class hours. The credit fees and tuition mentioned herein are referred to as the credit fees.
3. In addition to the tuition and other required fees, students should also pay the following:
 - a. Student Group Insurance: NT\$595 per semester (the exact amount is subject to the bid award result)
 - b. Language Lab Fee: NT\$530 (for freshmen of daytime and evening undergraduate programs, and juniors of two-year bachelor's degree programs)
 - c. Computer Lab & Internet Fee: NT\$830 (for freshmen and sophomores of daytime and evening undergraduate programs, juniors of two-year bachelor's degree programs, and new transfer students)
 - d. Accommodation Fee:
 - Dormitory 1: building A NT\$13,900 per person/semester ; building C.D NT\$18,500 per person/semester
 - Dormitory 2: NT\$4,290 per person/month (11 months of accommodation + a deposit of NT\$4,290)
 - Medical Campus Dormitory: NT\$17,500 per person/semester for a triple room
 - ISU International House: NT\$42,000 per person for the first semester and NT\$35,000 per person for the second semester (plus a deposit of NT\$7,000)
4. Student Loan Package: (1) tuition and other required fees; (2) Student Group Insurance premiums; (3) accommodation fees; (4) books and supplies; (5) expenses on overseas studies; and (6) living allowances for students from low-income families. The loan limit for qualified students is NT\$8,000 per person/month with a maximum of NT\$40,000 per person/semester (five months constitute one semester). The living allowances for students from medium- or low-income families are a maximum of NT\$20,000 per person/semester.
5. For students enrolled at the Division of Continuing Education, the fees for core and liberal arts courses are calculated based on the number of credits or the number of class hours. The fee per credit is NT\$1,533. For daytime undergraduates, the fee per credit of core and liberal arts courses is NT\$2,070. For students enrolled at the Division of Continuing Education who are eligible to have all the courses he/she takes offered by daytime programs, the Regulations for Inter-Division Course Registration between Daytime Undergraduate Programs and Division of Continuing Education at I-Shou University shall apply.
6. As per the Ministry of Education's Letter No. Tai-88-Ji-Er-Zi 88058056, when students who have extended the graduation date take nine credits or less, only credit fees will be collected; if such students take ten credits or more, the full tuition and other required fees will be collected.
7. As per the Ministry of Education's Letter No. Tai-87-Ji-Er-Zi 87067583, regarding courses on military education, physical education, practicum or experiments, the fees per credit are calculated and collected on an hourly basis only, and course instructors present in the course of instruction receive hourly pay based on individual teaching hours.
8. As per the Ministry of Education's Letter No. Tai-Kao-Si-Zi 0990184073 dated October 25, 2010, the sum of the tuition and other required fees are NT\$72,500 for freshmen admitted to the International College in or after Academic Year 2011.
9. As per the Ministry of Education's Letter No. Tai-88-Ji-Er-Zi 88058056, when students who take an internship outside the University for the entire semester, only full tuition and four-fifths of other required fees will be collected.
10. If students take an internship outside the University or study abroad as an exchange student (including in mainland China), the tuition and other required fees should be collected according to the standards below:

Standards for Tuition and Other Required Fees for Students Taking an Internship outside the University or Studying Abroad as an Exchange Student (including in mainland China)

Adopted on November 23, 2011 at the six meeting of the University Administration Council in the first semester of the academic year 2011

Amendments to the Standards ratified and promulgated by the President on July 19, 2018

- I. Full tuition and other required fees are collected from exchange students (applicable to those who only pay the tuition and other required fees of the home university) and students pursuing a joint dual-degree in mainland China.
- II. For students who study abroad but not mentioned above:
 1. One-third of full tuition and other required fees are collected if the student receives up to NT\$50,000 in scholarship for one semester (awarded by both the University and organizations outside the University).
 2. Two-thirds of full tuition and other required fees are collected if the student receives NT\$50,001-150,000 in scholarship for one semester (awarded by both the University and organizations outside the University).
 3. Full tuition and other required fees are collected if the student receives more than NT\$150,000 in scholarship for one semester (awarded by both the University and organizations outside the University).
- III. Internships:
 1. Full tuition and other required fees are collected from students who take an internship outside the University and take courses at the University as well.
 2. Full tuition and 80% of other required fees are collected from students who take an internship outside the University but don't take any course at the University.
 3. Two-thirds of full tuition and other required fees are collected from students who take an internship abroad and don't take any course at the University.
- IV. Students who pursue studies abroad or take an internship outside the University shall first pay full tuition and other required fees, and then apply for a refund to the department they belong to after the semester ends or they have completed the studies/internship.
